FIELD NOTES

This would have been the second year for the e3/ Berean partnership to go to India, but no Bereans were able to join us. The other church, Waves of Faith did return to help us carry on the work that God has begun in N.E. India.

FRUIT

We fielded a team of 5 e3 leaders and 13 Expeditioners, and overcame some significant obstacles to evangelize, disciple and plant more churches in this region. A transportation strike cost us one full day in the field. Threats following the strike delayed the train that was going to bring us back to Delhi for our flight home by 12 hours. Yet, the team walked in faith, did not complain, but carried out the mission in love, and with grace and passion. Five new

churches will be planted and 2 churches were strengthened. Also, 13 “third generation” churches had been planted since our last visit. This is a sign that a church planting movement has begun in at least one area, in the first two years in Bongaigaon district.

We are beginning our third year of church planting missions together in Assam, India. God has blessed our teams to have planted over 30 new churches in this region of India. Over 13 churches have been born from the churches that we planted in 2010, giving rise to our first church planting movement in north-east India.

This year we will be using medical clinics in the villages to serve the peoples' medical needs and to share the gospel. We will also be fitting some of them with "magnifier" glasses to help them see clearly. And our evangelism teams will be out in the villages daily to share the gospel and to do discipleship with new believers in their homes.
