### FIELD NOTES

This year the Bereans along with some other US friends joined together to continue a journey God laid before the team in serving our Kenyan Brothers and Sisters in Church Planting in Africa. This was year two in a long term strategy to start a movement along the Kenyan Coast that would continue on towards the unreached nomadic tribes along the northeastern border.

### FRUIT

This year we moved to a new location to continue encouraging and modeling a church planting and discipleship focus along the coast. The harvest field again was ripe this year. Along with great success in HIV/AIDs training, this

Follow-Up: A portion of your campaign cost is used solely for the follow-up, leadership training, and discipleship of the new believers and churches.

Leadership Training: The national leaders are trained prior to campaign.
