FIELD NOTES

SportReach and the Berean fellowship have been working in Peru for over 7 years. This year we have had the chance to pass the torch to the nationals in the Huancayo Valley while opening a new work in the Sacred Valley. As we were preparing the team for this new work in Urubamba, we heard of the tough soil, spiritual darkness, and slammed doors that came to a team who recently worked there. So, we prepared heavily in prayer and spiritually, asking that this team would be able to breakthrough in this area.

We also saw house church plants thrive and leaders unite in a common goal of reaching this valley and making His name famous.

BEREAN'S IN THE FIELD

A strong team of 21 served in the Sacred Valley and of those, 9 were Bereans. Around 50% of the team were youth and we formed 3 sports teams and 1 evangelism team. Peru continues to be a strong area of need and Urubamba is a strategic focus that has much more work to be done.
